



# PLAY PAEDIATRIC CONSULT

## Terms of Agreement

(Home Consultation)

Kindly read through these terms of agreement thoroughly before filling the registration form. You may seek clarifications on areas that may not be explicit enough.

- (1) Play Paediatric Consult (PPC) is a registered private medical outfit that provides paediatric services for minor ailments to children who are registered under the scheme. PPC operates an outpatient clinic, telemedicine consultation and also provides home services. Solely Dr Bolasere Olawuyi, who is the paediatrician-in-charge and the director of the consult, renders the services. The consult, through home visits, shall provide medical care for minor ailments for any child below the age of 18 years. The service basically involves, listening to the health complaints of the child (through the assistance of the parent or care-giver), doing a physical examination, making a diagnosis and offering the appropriate medical advice. Such advice may be by way of prescribing the appropriate treatment (be it drug treatment or otherwise) to the child. Sometimes the child may be required to have a laboratory test done before a diagnosis can be established. Registration with the consult is per child. For home consultation, the paediatrician shall visit the home of the client to attend to the complaints of only the registered child at a stipulated fee, upon the request of the parent/guardian through an online booking platform at <https://playpaediatric.simplybook.me>.
- (2) On each home visit, the paediatrician shall listen to the complaints of the child (as given by the parent/guardian), examine the child thoroughly and offer advice on the best remedy. The procurement and cost implication of such a remedy shall be the responsibility of the parent/guardian. The

- paediatrician may, however, offer assistance in administering such a remedy (e.g. injections) where necessary.
- (3) Where laboratory or radiological investigations are required, the stipulated fees of PPC will be paid by the parent accordingly. There is, however, the option of the parent taking the child to a laboratory of their choice at their own cost.
  - (4) Registration Form for PPC (home consultation or clinic consultation) can be downloaded online at [www.playpaediatricconsult.com](http://www.playpaediatricconsult.com)
  - (5) A yearly registration fee is paid per child and a consultation fee per home visit per child. Please find attached the current fees or call 08075549815 to enquire.
  - (6) All payments are to be made into any of these bank accounts of the consult:
    - (a) **Access Bank; Account No: 0804784832 ; Account Name: PLAY PAEDIATRIC CONSULT**
    - (b) **Guaranty Trust Bank; Account No: 0592702637; Account Name: PLAY PAEDIATRIC CONSULT**
  - (7) Payments could be made via internet bank transfer or point-of-sale (POS) machine provided. There is also the option of online payment via [paystack.com](http://paystack.com).
  - (8) Each home visit shall not last more than 60 minutes to all intents and purposes. Every subsequent extra time spent will be paid for in multiples of N2,000 per 15 minutes.
  - (9) PPC will attempt to provide the prescribed drugs but where not available, such drugs shall be procured by the parent/guardian from a reliable pharmacy at their own expense.

- (10) Consultations shall be made ONLY at the address stated as the child's home address in the registration form or the booking form.
- (11) Home consultation is presently limited to Lekki-Victoria Island-Ikoyi axis of Lagos, Nigeria. In the event of a change of address, the management of PPC should be immediately informed via an email message to [info@playpaediatricconsult.com](mailto:info@playpaediatricconsult.com) . However, home visits will not be provided at any address outside Lekki-Victoria Island-Ikoyi axis.
- (12) Appointment booking requesting the attention of the paediatrician shall be ONLY for the child(ren) specifically called for.
- (13) Other services rendered by the paediatrician aside mere consultation shall be paid for accordingly. Such ancillary services may include provision of drugs, laboratory investigations, nebulization, wound dressing, etc.
- (14) Home visits will not be made more than once a day for any single child. However, further enquiries may be made through phone conversations.
- (15) For cases requiring hospital admission, the parent/guardian will be appropriately advised to take the child to the nearest health institution that can handle such a condition. PPC management may also suggest a hospital considered best suitable for the treatment of the illness. Further management of the child shall be solely at the discretion of the doctors in such a health institution. The PPC paediatrician will, however, be glad to furnish the managing doctors with relevant information that may assist in their management of the case.
- (16) The paediatrician will endeavour to be at your home at the exact appointment time booked. However, unforeseen circumstances (especially traffic jam) may sometimes make it not feasible.
- (17) Please note that the PPC paediatrician does not go out in the night for consultation of any kind. Home consultation is simply within the available period on the booking page.
